



----- Field Rules -----

1. Members must setup targets starting from the right hand side of the shooting area and work inwards.
2. A shooting line **MUST** be used at all times.
3. To operate independent shooting lines they must be a **MINIMUM** distance of 25yds apart.
4. Bosses must **ALWAYS** be tied down.
5. Coaching on the line should not be carried out if members are shooting a round for classification purposes. Coaching should be carried out on an independent shooting line.
6. If other members are shooting a round please try not to delay them.
7. Put all equipment back in the shed when you have finished and in the correct locations. (Please do not assume somebody will arrive after you to use it)
8. Remove any tie down nails from the side of the boss.
9. Neatly tie up all ropes (tie down and line).
10. Broken arrow points must be removed from the boss. (Otherwise mark the location and report it to the Equipment Officer)
11. Breakages and equipment faults **MUST** be reported immediately to the Club Equipment Officer.
12. Please place any old targets or paper litter in the bin provided. Do not leave food in the bin as this attracts mice etc into the shed – take it with you.
13. Cars are **NOT** to be parked on the field unless special permission has been given by either the Archery Warehouse or a member of the committee.
